TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RACE PARTICIPATION :

While the Event Organiser ("SCCF") has taken every reasonable measure to ensure your safety, there are hazards and dangers inherent in any competitive sporting event. As a participant in Sedan Chair Race, every racer is responsible for his/her own safety and enter this event at one's own risk.

SCCF will cover the race with public liability only. Participants should be responsible for their own personal accident insurance.

It is important that you read and understand the following safety message in conjunction with your waiver and declaration and adhere to each of the safety guidelines of the event.

SAFETY REMINDER :

1. The Race (as defined above) attracts a significant number of spectators. Public safety must be at the forefront of your mind at all times. You must follow the directions of SCCF or its representatives (including the race committee, race officials, race marshals, race volunteers and Duty Police).
2. At all times you must obey the instructions of SCCF and its representatives. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the Race.
3. All clothing, uniforms or costumes worn by each team member and/or any alterations made or decorations attached to your Sedan Chair must be safe, in good condition, appropriate and cause no danger to any other race participants, supporters or members of the public during the Race.
4. Please also refer to **[2012 Rules of Race]** for other information and instructions. The [2012 Rules of Race] will be distributed during the race briefing meeting to be held in September / October 2012.

DECLARATION AND WAIVER:

1. Team Captain and team members ("We") agree to assume full responsibility for all personal possessions and equipment during the Sedan Chair Race and Bazaar (the "Race").
2. We agree to abide by the rules set by the Sedan Chair Charities Fund ("SCCF") and instructions given by SCCF and its representatives, including the race committee, race officials, race marshals, race volunteers and Duty Police during the Race.
3. We understand that SCCF and its related entities, representatives, contractors, agents, officers, committee members, employees and sponsors ("Representatives") accept no liability for any death, injury or loss to race team members, supporters or members of the public, nor liability for any damage to personal property of race team members, supporters or members of the public arising directly or indirectly in connection with the Race (including during race practice). Each team member accepts full responsibility for any injury or accident or loss incurred or caused by such team member or damage to property that may arise directly or indirectly in connection with the Race (including during race practice), and each team member releases and discharges SCCF and its Representatives from any and all liability for any such death, injury, loss or damage, howsoever caused, whether as a result of any negligent act or omission, breach of statutory duty, or otherwise.
4. We acknowledge that participating in the Race includes hazards and danger and each team member acknowledges that such team member participates in this event of their own volition and at their own risk.
5. We declare that each team member has no physical or mental disability or health problem, whether temporary or permanent, which could affect our ability to participate safely in the Race.
6. We declare that each team member is not and will not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, and have not and will not consume any medication, prescription or otherwise, which may reduce each team member's ability to participate safely in the Race.
7. We declare that each team member has sufficient experience and physical capability to participate in the Race. Each team member declares that such team member is able to hold and control the Chair provided by the event organiser to a reasonably safe standard, in race conditions.
8. We understand that Sedan Chair Charities Fund Committee reserves the right to use all photos and promotional material connected with the Event for promotional purposes.
9. We acknowledge that notwithstanding the cancellation or re-scheduling of the Race for any reason, the registration fee, minimum team donation and any other sponsorship fee shall be non-refundable.
10. As the Team Captain, by or before signing this Declaration and Waiver, I confirm to SCCF that, each team member has read, understood and confirmed each of the above mentioned terms and conditions and I confirm that I am signing this Declaration on behalf of each team member, with their consent and authorisation.

TEAMS: Teams shall consist of all males, all females or mixed runners of a maximum of 9 persons, one of whom must be the passenger. Passengers must be over 16 years, alive and human, and must remain in the chair throughout the entire race. Ladies and School teams may have a dummy weighing at least 10kg instead of a passenger. One official cheerleader to run with the team is optional but must not touch the chair at any time during the race. School teams must comprise of a minimum of three boys and three girls.

CHAIRS: A sedan chair and 2 poles are provided; these are available for teams to take away and decorate from around late September. No alteration to the width of the chair is permitted. The chair cannot be wheeled around the course. Practice chairs will be provided on site for team practice on the course itself before Event Day.

FITNESS: Participants MUST be physically fit. It is recommended as part of team-building that teams are familiar with the course and have at least 2 practice runs (with a passenger if appropriate for your category) before the Event. Neither MIH nor the Sedan Chair Charities Fund Committee is responsible for injuries or damages incurred during practice or the actual race.

RULES: Teams will begin the race in pairs according to a pre-determined line-up order and starting time (determined by ballot). The elapsed time will be determined when the head of the passenger in the chair crosses the finish line. It is not necessary for all team members to cross the line together. Chair numbers must be prominently displayed at the front and top of the chair. On course, teams should run on the left and overtake on the right. No complaints against any team by any other will be entertained.

Super Eight Challenge 2.1 km. Clockwise from back gates of MIH around Mt Kellett Road via Homestead Road and back. **Recommended for "serious" fit teams committed to training because this Category is to compete for "speed".**
